Results of Feb. 25 congregational meeting

Pastor Mary spoke about the role Little Brown Church plays in the Sunol community at the congregational meeting. Council Chair Allen Cook described the many steps taken in the past year to maintain our sanctuary, Babbitt Hall, parsonage (which is being rented at market rate) and Kirk House. Maintenance and repairs include electrical upgrades, a concrete pad for the new storage shed, septic tank pumping and assessment, termite inspection and abatement, improved lighting, and a new porch and other work on the church and parsonage. Projects in the near future include construction and painting of the new storage shed, repairs to the courtyard fountain, repairs to the floor in Babbitt Hall and new linoleum. Members of the greater community as well as members of the church have donated time, materials, and money to these projects that keep our 133-year-old church in good repair.
