Little Brown Church Fountain

Greetings, everyone.

We were able to hold a long overdue church council meeting October 21 with a quorum of attendees. A few items to report on:

After many, many months we now have the courtyard fountain repaired and running again. It's nice to hear the splash of water cascading down from one level to the next. The motor had burnt out when the fountain was left on during a week-day event and had run dry. To help prevent possible future damage to the motor we added a weatherproof wireless remote control outlet for powering the fountain motor.

In Babbitt Hall's kitchen we upgraded the coffee machine to one that has an auto-off feature. In the past, we have encountered multiple times of finding the coffee maker being left on for days, after use during the week. The auto-off function eliminates this issue.
