The bad news is that Niles Canyon will be closed to automobile traffic on Sunday, May 1, which will make attending Little Brown Church that morning a little more difficult for worshipers who live outside of Sunol.

If you're driving from Pleasanton or Livermore, you'll need to take Foothill Road (instead of Main Street) to reach Kilkare Road. If you're coming from the Fremont area, you'll need to take I-680 to Highway 84 to Main Street to Bond to Foothill to Kilkare.

On the plus side, you'll have a chance to check out various attractions on Main Street and get lunch at the local restaurants or food trucks, and even walk into Niles Canyon as far as you want without having to dodge motor vehicles.
