May 1 – Niles Canyon Roll and Stroll

As mentioned in the April newsletter and church bulletins, Niles Canyon will be closed to automobile traffic this Sunday, May 1, so that walkers and bicyclists can stroll or cycle through our beautiful canyon without risking their lives. This will make attending Little Brown Church that morning a little more difficult for worshipers who live outside of Sunol.

If you're driving from Pleasanton or Livermore, you'll need to take Foothill Road (instead of Main Street) to reach Kilkare Road. If you're coming from the Fremont area, you'll need to take I-680 to Highway 84 to Main Street to Bond to Foothill to Kilkare.

On the plus side, you'll have a chance to check out various attractions on Main Street and get lunch at the local restaurants or food trucks, and even walk into Niles Canyon as far as you want without having to dodge motor vehicles.

Sunol Repertory Theater

Little Brown Church will be providing refreshments at the Saturday, May 21, performance by Sunol Repertory Theater. We are still working out the details, but please let us know if you are interested in helping by replying to this email or by speaking with Mary or Barbara at church. The performance that day starts at 5 p.m.

Almost everything else is different this season following a two-year hiatus due to the pandemic: performances are in May instead of March; outdoors instead of indoors; in the Sunol Depot Gardens park on Main Street instead of at Sunol Glen School; and afternoons instead of evenings: 5-7 p.m. on Saturdays, May 14 and 21, and 3-5 p.m. on Sundays, May 15 and 22.
